Bill Number: **HB 2483**

Payne Floor Amendment

The Payne floor amendment dated February 20, 2023 at 1:38 PM:

- Clarifies that a municipality or county may not enact any law, ordinance or regulation which prohibits a resident of a single-family detached residence which is less than one-half acre from keeping fowl in the property's backyard except under certain circumstances.
- Authorizes a municipality or county to enact a law, ordinance or regulation that:
 - Restricts the number of fowl a resident may keep in the property's backyard to no more than six.
 - Requires fowl to be kept in an enclosure in the property's rear or side yard which cannot be taller than 8 feet in height.
