FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

1. Requires, retroactive to July 1, 2022, state aid to be withheld from a community college district (CCD) that exceeds its expenditure limit for FYs 2024 through 2026 in the following amounts, rather than as statutorily prescribed:
 - a. \$5,000, if the excess expenditures are less than 5 percent of the limit;
 - b. \$15,000, if the excess expenditures are at least 5 percent and under 10 percent of the limit;
 - c. \$20,000, if the excess expenditures are at least 10 percent and under 12 percent of the limit; or
 - d. an amount equal to the lesser of one-third of the state aid allocation or five times the excess expenditures, if excess expenditures are at least 12 percent of the limit.
2. Caps, retroactive to July 1, 2022, at one percent of the provisional CCD's budget, the amount of state aid that may be withheld from a provisional CCD established before December 31, 2015, in a county with a population that does not exceed 300,000 persons.
3. Makes conforming changes.

2 "Sec. 6. Community college districts; expenditure limitations;
3 withholding

4 A. Notwithstanding section 41-1279.07, Arizona Revised Statutes, for
5 fiscal years 2023-2024, 2024-2025 and 2025-2026, if a community college
6 district exceeds its expenditure limitation prescribed in article IX,
7 section 21, Constitution of Arizona, and pursuant to section 41-563,
8 Arizona Revised Statutes, the community college district shall have its
9 state aid pursuant to section 15-1466, Arizona Revised Statutes, withheld
10 as follows:

11 1. If the excess expenditures are less than five percent of the
12 limitation, an amount equal to \$5,000.

13 2. If the excess expenditures are equal to or greater than five percent
14 but less than ten percent of the limitation, an amount equal to \$15,000.

15 3. If the excess expenditures are equal to or greater than ten percent
16 but less than twelve percent of the limitation, an amount equal to \$20,000.

17 4. If the excess expenditures are equal to or greater than twelve
18 percent of the limitation, an amount calculated pursuant to section 41-
19 1279.07, Arizona Revised Statutes, except that for any provisional
20 community college district established pursuant to section 15-1402.01,
21 Arizona Revised Statutes, before December 31, 2015 that is in a county with
22 a population of less than three hundred thousand persons, the maximum
23 amount of state aid withheld may not exceed one percent of the provisional
24 community college district budget."
