18 C. Notwithstanding any other law, the following amounts are reduced
19 from appropriations made to the following state agency in fiscal year
20 2023-2024 by Laws 2023, chapter 135, section 20 for the following project:

22 Design and construct additional vehicle
23 lanes, separated by a lighted median,
24 on Interstate 10 between State Route 85
25 and Citrus Road \$(52,090,000)

1 E. Notwithstanding any other law, on or before June 30, 2024,
2 \$55,910,000 from the state highway fund established by section 28-6991,
3 Arizona Revised Statutes, is transferred to the state general fund for the
4 purposes of providing adequate support and maintenance for agencies of
5 this state. This amount reflects a portion of the revenues derived from
6 the tax levied by title 42, chapter 5, articles 1 and 5, Arizona Revised
7 Statutes, that were transferred to the state highway fund by Laws 2022,
8 chapter 321, section 20, subsection A, paragraph 2.

9 F. The sum of ~~\$30,000,000~~ ~~[\$70,000,000]~~ [\$40,000,000] is
10 appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year ~~2026-2027~~
11 2025-2026 and the sum of ~~\$78,000,000~~ ~~[\$50,000,000]~~ [\$93,000,000] is
12 appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year ~~2027-2028~~
13 2026-2027 to the department of transportation to design and construct
14 additional vehicle lanes, separated by a lighted median, on Interstate 10
15 between State Route 85 and Citrus Road. TO EXPEDITE CONSTRUCTION AND
16 ENSURE COMPLETION OF THIS PROJECT IN A TIMELY MANNER, THE DEPARTMENT OF
17 TRANSPORTATION SHALL PROCURE [CONSTRUCTION-MANAGER-AT-RISK OR DESIGN-BUILD
18 CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 34-603, ARIZONA REVISED
19 STATUTES] [CONSTRUCTION BIDS THAT INCORPORATE THE COST-PLUS-TIME (A+B)
20 METHOD].
