2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 34, Arizona Revised Statutes, is 3 amended by adding section 13-3411.01, to read:

- 4 13-3411.01. <u>Sale. transfer. possession or use of dangerous</u>
 5 <u>drugs or narcotic drugs in a drug-free homeless</u>
 6 <u>service zone: classification: definitions</u>
 7 A. IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 1. INTENTIONALLY BE PRESENT IN A DRUG-FREE HOMELESS SERVICE ZONE TO 9 SELL OR TRANSFER DANGEROUS DRUGS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS.

10 2. IF THE PERSON IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A FACILITY-BASED SERVICE THAT 11 PRIMARILY SERVES HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND THAT RECEIVES STATE, LOCAL OR 12 FEDERAL MONIES, KNOWINGLY VIOLATE ANY FORMAL POLICY THAT IS ADOPTED 13 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION F OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING INTENTIONALLY ALLOWING 14 THE POSSESSION OR USE OF DANGEROUS DRUGS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS IN A DRUG-FREE 15 HOMELESS SERVICE ZONE.

B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SECTION IF IS GUILTY OF THE SAME CLASS OF FELONY THAT THE PERSON WOULD OTHERWISE BE BUILTY OF HAD THE VIOLATION NOT OCCURRED WITHIN A DRUG-FREE HOMELESS SERVICE ZONE, EXCEPT THAT THE PRESUMPTIVE, MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM SENTENCES O SHALL BE INCREASED BY ONE YEAR. THE ADDITIONAL SENTENCE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS IN ADDITION TO ANY ENHANCED PUNISHMENT THAT MAY BE APPLICABLE UNDER SECTION 13-703 OR 13-704, SECTION 13-708, SUBSECTION D OR ANY PROVISION IN THIS CHAPTER. A PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SUSPENSION OF SENTENCE, PROBATION, PARDON OR RELEASE FROM CONFINEMENT ON ANY BASIS EXCEPT PURSUANT TO SECTION 31-233, SUBSECTION A OR B UNTIL THE SENTENCE IMPOSED BY THE COURT HAS BEEN SERVED OR IS COMMUTED.

27 C. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SECTION 28 IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR.

D. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PRESCRIBED BY THIS TITLE, THE 1 2 COURT SHALL ORDER A PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION 3 TO PAY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$2,000 OR THREE TIMES THE VALUE, AS 4 DETERMINED BY THE COURT, OF THE DRUGS INVOLVED IN OR GIVING RISE TO THE 5 CHARGE, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, AND NOT MORE THAN THE MAXIMUM AUTHORIZED BY 6 CHAPTER 8 OF THIS TITLE. A JUDGE MAY NOT SUSPEND ANY PART OR ALL OF THE 7 IMPOSITION OF ANY FINE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION. 8 E. EACH OPERATOR OR PROVIDER OF FACILITY-BASED SERVICES THAT 9 PRIMARILY SERVE HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS SHALL PLACE AND MAINTAIN A 10 PERMANENTLY AFFIXED SIGN LOCATED IN A VISIBLE MANNER INSIDE THE FACILITY 11 AND OUTSIDE THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE FACILITY THAT IDENTIFIES THE BUILDING 12 AND ITS ACCOMPANYING GROUNDS AS A DRUG-FREE HOMELESS SERVICE ZONE. IF AN 13 OPERATOR OR PROVIDER OF FACILITY-BASED SERVICES PRIMARILY SERVES DOMESTIC 14 VIOLENCE VICTIMS OR FAMILIES. THE OPERATOR OR PROVIDER SHALL PLACE AND 15 MAINTAIN A PERMANENTLY AFFIXED SIGN LOCATED IN A VISIBLE MANNER INSIDE THE 16 FACILITY THAT IDENTIFIES THE BUILDING AS A DRUG-FREE HOMELESS SERVICE

17 ZONE.
18 F. AN OPERATOR OF FACILITY-BASED SERVICES THAT SERVE HOMELESS
19 INDIVIDUALS MUST ADOPT A FORMAL POLICY THAT PROHIBITS THE USE OR
20 POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS WITHIN DRUG-FREE HOMELESS
21 SERVICE ZONES.

22 [G. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO POSSESSES DANGEROUS
 23 DRUGS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS PURSUANT TO A PRESCRIPTION THAT IS PRESCRIBED BY A
 24 PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13 OR 17.]

25 [G.] [H.]FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

261. "DRUG-FREE HOMELESS SERVICE ZONE" MEANS A FACILITY AND ITS27ACCOMPANYING GROUNDS IN WHICH SERVICES, SHELTER OR PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE28HOUSING ARE PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS.

29 2. "HOMELESS INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT HAVE A 30 HOME OR PERMANENT PLACE OF RESIDENCE.
