## FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

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1. Prohibits a locality from enacting any ordinance, regulation or rule that allows a marijuana establishment to be located within 500 feet of a public school, private school, child care facility or facility that provides preschool programs.
2. Applies the location restrictions on nonprofit medical marijuana dispensaries and marijuana establishments only to nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary registration certificates and marijuana establishment licenses issued after the general effective date.
3. Makes conforming changes.

2       Section 1. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,  
3 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2804, Arizona Revised  
4 Statutes, is amended to read:  
5       36-2804. Registration and certification of nonprofit medical  
6               marijuana dispensaries  
7       A. Nonprofit medical marijuana dispensaries shall register with the  
8 department.  
9       B. Not later than ninety days after receiving an application for a  
10 nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary, the department shall register the  
11 nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary and issue a registration  
12 certificate and a random ~~20-digit~~ TWENTY-DIGIT alphanumeric identification  
13 number if:  
14       1. The prospective nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary has  
15 submitted the following:  
16       (a) The application fee.  
17       (b) An application, including:  
18       (i) The legal name of the nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary.  
19       (ii) The physical address of the nonprofit medical marijuana  
20 dispensary and the physical address of one additional location, if any,  
21 where marijuana will be cultivated, neither of which may be within five  
22 hundred feet of a public or private school, A CHILD CARE FACILITY OR A  
23 FACILITY THAT PROVIDES PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS existing before the date of the  
24 nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary application.  
25       (iii) The name, address and date of birth of each principal officer  
26 and board member of the nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary.  
27       (iv) The name, address and date of birth of each nonprofit medical  
28 marijuana dispensary agent.

1       (c) Operating procedures consistent with department rules for  
2 oversight of the nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary, including  
3 procedures to ensure accurate ~~record-keeping~~ RECORDKEEPING and adequate  
4 security measures.

5       (d) If the city, town or county in which the nonprofit medical  
6 marijuana dispensary would be located has enacted zoning restrictions, a  
7 sworn statement certifying that the registered nonprofit medical marijuana  
8 dispensary is in compliance with the restrictions.

9           2. None of the principal officers or board members has been  
10 convicted of an excluded felony offense.

11          3. None of the principal officers or board members has served as a  
12 principal officer or board member for a registered nonprofit medical  
13 marijuana dispensary that has had its registration certificate revoked.

14          4. None of the principal officers or board members is under  
15 twenty-one years of age.

16       C. The department may not issue more than one nonprofit medical  
17 marijuana dispensary registration certificate for every ten pharmacies  
18 that have registered under section 32-1929, have obtained a pharmacy  
19 permit from the Arizona STATE board of pharmacy and operate within the  
20 state, except that the department may issue nonprofit medical marijuana  
21 dispensary registration certificates in excess of this limit if necessary  
22 to ensure that the department issues at least one nonprofit medical  
23 marijuana dispensary registration certificate in each county in which an  
24 application has been approved.

25       D. The department may conduct a criminal records check in order to  
26 carry out this section.

27           <<Sec. 2. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,  
28 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2857, Arizona Revised  
29 Statutes, is amended to read:

30       36-2857. Localities: marijuana establishments and marijuana  
31                   testing facilities

32       A. A locality may:

33           1. Enact reasonable zoning regulations that limit the use of land  
34 for marijuana establishments and marijuana testing facilities to specified  
35 areas.

36           2. Limit the number of marijuana establishments or marijuana  
37 testing facilities, or both.

38           3. Prohibit marijuana establishments or marijuana testing  
39 facilities, or both.

40           4. Regulate the time, place and manner of marijuana establishment  
41 and marijuana testing facility operations.

42           5. Establish reasonable restrictions on public signage regarding  
43 marijuana, marijuana establishments and marijuana testing facilities.

44           6. Prohibit or restrict delivery within its jurisdiction.

45       B. A county may exercise its authority pursuant to subsection A of  
46 this section only in unincorporated areas of the county.

47       C. A locality may not enact any ordinance, regulation or rule that:

1       1. Is more restrictive than a comparable ordinance, regulation or  
2 rule that applies to nonprofit medical marijuana dispensaries.  
3       2. Makes the operation of a marijuana establishment or marijuana  
4 testing facility unduly burdensome if the locality has not prohibited  
5 marijuana establishments or marijuana testing facilities.  
6       3. Conflicts with this chapter or rules adopted pursuant to this  
7 chapter.  
8       4. Prohibits the transportation of marijuana by a marijuana  
9 establishment or marijuana testing facility on public roads.  
10      5. Restricts or interferes with the ability of a dual licensee or  
11 an entity eligible to become a dual licensee to operate a nonprofit  
12 medical marijuana dispensary and a marijuana establishment cooperatively  
13 at shared locations.  
14      6. Except as expressly authorized by this section or section  
15 36-2851, prohibits or restricts any conduct or transaction allowed by this  
16 chapter, or imposes any liability or penalty in addition to that  
17 prescribed by this chapter for any conduct or transaction constituting a  
18 violation of this chapter.

19     [7. ALLOWS A MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENT TO LOCATE WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED  
20 FEET OF A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL, A CHILD CARE FACILITY OR A FACILITY  
21 THAT PROVIDES PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS.]>>

22     <<Sec. 3. Applicability

23     [This act applies to any nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary  
24 registration certificate or marijuana establishment license that is issued  
25 on or after the effective date of this act.]>>

26     Sec. 4. Requirements for enactment: three-fourths vote

27     Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,  
28 [section][sections] 36-2804 [and 36-2857], Arizona Revised Statutes, as  
29 amended by this act, [is][are] effective only on the affirmative vote of  
30 at least three-fourths of the members of each house of the legislature.
