1 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 2, article 3, Arizona Revised
2 Statutes, is amended by adding section 28-377, to read:

3 28-377. Electric charging locations; reporting requirements;
4 definition

5 A. AN ENTITY, COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY OR STATE AGENCY THAT APPROVES OR
6 PERMITS AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION FOR PUBLIC ~~[OR PRIVATE]~~ USE
7 ON THEIR PROPERTY SHALL REPORT AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT
8 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

9 1. THE LOCATION OF THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION.

10 2. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PARKING SPOTS DESIGNATED FOR ELECTRIC
11 VEHICLE CHARGING.

12 B. [ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2025 AND ONCE EVERY QUARTER
13 THEREAFTER.] THE DIRECTOR SHALL COMPILE A LIST OF ALL ELECTRIC VEHICLE
14 CHARGING STATIONS IN THIS STATE AND ~~[POST THE LIST ON THE DEPARTMENT'S~~
15 ~~PUBLIC WEBSITE]~~ [PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE
16 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.] THE ~~[LIST]~~[REPORT] SHALL BE
17 UPDATED [WEEKLY][QUARTERLY] TO REFLECT ANY NEW OR DECOMMISSIONED ELECTRIC
18 VEHICLE CHARGING LOCATIONS.

19 [C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ENTITY" MEANS ANY BUSINESS
20 THAT PROVIDES FOR THE USE OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS ON THE
21 BUSINESS'S PROPERTY.]
