## FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

---

---

1. Specifies that a municipality or county may not enact any ordinance, rule or regulation that restricts or prohibits general construction activities during certain hours between May 1 and October 15 of each year, rather than between May 1 and September 31 of each year.
2. Adds the hours of between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Saturdays to the prescribed time periods a municipality or county is prohibited from enacting an ordinance, rule or regulation that restricts general construction activities during the summertime period.
3. Adds an emergency clause.

- 4       9-500.52. Construction: summertime hours: prohibition on restriction
- 5           A. A MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT ENACT ANY ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION THAT RESTRICTS OR PROHIBITS GENERAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES BETWEEN MAY 1 AND [SEPTEMBER 31][OCTOBER 15] OF EACH YEAR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 5:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. EACH BUSINESS DAY [AND BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY] IF THE CONSTRUCTION WORK IS BEING PERFORMED PURSUANT TO A VALIDLY ISSUED BUILDING PERMIT ISSUED BY THE MUNICIPALITY.
- 6           B. THE MUNICIPALITY SHALL ALLOW CONCRETE TO BE POURED AT LEAST ONE HOUR BEFORE THE TIME THAT GENERAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ARE REGULARLY SCHEDULED TO BEGIN.
- 7       Sec. 2. Title 11, chapter 2, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 11-269.30, to read:
- 8       11-269.30. Construction: summertime hours: prohibition on restriction
- 9           A. A COUNTY MAY NOT ENACT ANY ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION THAT RESTRICTS OR PROHIBITS GENERAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES BETWEEN MAY 1 AND [SEPTEMBER 31][OCTOBER 15] OF EACH YEAR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 5:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. EACH BUSINESS DAY [AND BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY] IF THE CONSTRUCTION WORK IS BEING PERFORMED PURSUANT TO A VALIDLY ISSUED BUILDING PERMIT ISSUED BY THE COUNTY.
- 10          B. THE COUNTY SHALL ALLOW CONCRETE TO BE POURED AT LEAST ONE HOUR BEFORE THE TIME THAT GENERAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ARE REGULARLY SCHEDULED TO BEGIN."
