FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Authorizes supervisors to allow employees who are sick to work remotely.**
- 2. Requires each state agency to require a full-time employee to perform the employee's assigned duties at the state agency's office during the employee's regularly scheduled work hours.**
- 3. Exempts a full-time employee, from the remote work prohibition, whose duties require the employee to perform any site visits or inspections or provide services at a location other than the state agency's office if the employee is performing the duties or providing the services during regularly scheduled work hours.**
- 4. States that virtual meetings and conference calls do not constitute remote work.**
- 5. Makes a conforming change.**

7 [A.] A FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE OF THIS STATE MAY NOT WORK REMOTELY[.
8 SUPERVISORS MAY ALLOW EMPLOYEES WHO ARE SICK TO WORK REMOTELY.

9 B. EACH STATE AGENCY SHALL REQUIRE A FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE TO PERFORM
10 THE EMPLOYEE'S ASSIGNED DUTIES AT THE STATE AGENCY'S OFFICE DURING THE
11 EMPLOYEE'S REGULARLY SCHEDULED WORK HOURS. A FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE WHOSE
12 DUTIES REQUIRE THE EMPLOYEE TO PERFORM ANY SITE VISITS OR INSPECTIONS OR
13 PROVIDE SERVICES AT A LOCATION OTHER THAN THE STATE AGENCY'S OFFICE IS
14 EXEMPT FROM THIS SUBSECTION IF THE EMPLOYEE IS PERFORMING THE EMPLOYEE'S
15 DUTIES AT THE LOCATION OF THE SITE VISIT OR INSPECTION OR THE LOCATION
16 WHERE THE EMPLOYEE IS PROVIDING SERVICES DURING THE EMPLOYEE'S REGULARLY
17 SCHEDULED WORK HOURS.

18 C. VIRTUAL MEETINGS AND CONFERENCE CALLS DO NOT CONSTITUTE REMOTE
19 WORK PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION]."
