1 The resolution as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:  
2       Whereas, the Yuma growing area has excellent soils and an  
3 exceptional climate for agricultural production; and  
4       Whereas, the Yuma growing area has access to a skilled agricultural  
5 labor pool; and  
6       Whereas, the Yuma growing area has Priority 1 and Priority 3 rights  
7 to Colorado River water; and  
8       Whereas, as a result of these factors, the Yuma growing area  
9 produces or ships 90% of the leafy green vegetables consumed in North  
10 America from November to March; and  
11      Whereas, over 100 different crops are produced in the Yuma growing  
12 area; and  
13      Whereas, Yuma agriculture contributes \$4.2 billion to this state's  
14 economy; and  
15      Whereas, due to highly efficient irrigation practices, Yuma  
16 agriculture produces the most crop per drop of water of any irrigated area  
17 in the Colorado River basin; and  
18      Whereas, the combination of these conditions makes Yuma agriculture  
19 unique in the world and impossible to duplicate or replace; and  
20      Whereas, food security is a matter of national security.  
21 Therefore  
22 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,  
23 the Senate concurring:  
24      That it is the intent of the Legislature to protect [and preserve]  
25 Yuma agriculture and [the Yuma area's] [Arizona's] rights to Colorado  
26 River water.  
27 Enroll and engross to conform
