1 The bill as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2351. License plate provided; design

5 A. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall provide to
6 every owner one license plate for each vehicle registered. At the request
7 of the owner and on payment of a fee in an amount prescribed by the
8 director by rule, the department shall provide one additional license
9 plate for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested pursuant to
10 this chapter.

11 B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the
12 vehicle and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which
13 may be abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a
14 reflective material that is consistent with the determination of the
15 department regarding the color and design of license plates and special
16 plates. The director shall design the license plate and the letters and
17 numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly
18 readable during daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition
19 to the standard license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005,
20 the director shall issue a license plate for trailers that has a design
21 that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that
22 is the same size as the license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner
23 shall notify the department which size license plate the owner wants for
24 the trailer.

25 C. In addition to the requirements prescribed in subsection B of
26 this section, for all license plates, including all special plates, that
27 are designed or redesigned on or after September 24, 2022:

28 1. The background color of the license plate shall contrast
29 significantly with the color of the letters and numerals on the license
30 plate and with the name of this state on the license plate.

31 2. The name of this state shall appear on the license plate in
32 capital letters in sans serif font and be three-fourths of an inch in
33 height.

1 D. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract
2 with a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material
3 for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a
4 reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many
5 individual responsible respondents as possible.

6 E. The department shall determine the color and design of the
7 license plate subject to the requirements prescribed by subsections B and
8 C of this section. All plates issued by the department, except the plates
9 that are issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414,
10 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2470.26~~ ~~[28-2470.27]~~ [28-2470.32],
11 28-2472, 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475, 28-2476 and 28-4533 and article 14 of
12 this chapter, shall be the same color as and similar in design to the
13 license plate as determined by the department.

14 F. A passenger motor vehicle that is rented without a driver shall
15 receive the same type of license plate as is issued for a private
16 passenger motor vehicle.

17 Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
18 read:

19 28-2403. Special plates; transfers; violation; classification

20 A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department
21 shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates
22 pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the
23 requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates
24 are met:

25 1. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, a person
26 who is the registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or
27 who applies for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may
28 submit to the department a completed application form as prescribed by the
29 department with the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates
30 in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

31 2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412,
32 28-2413, 28-2414, 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2470.26~~
33 ~~[28-2470.27]~~ [28-2470.32], 28-2472, 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475 and 28-2476
34 and article 14 of this chapter, the special plates shall be the same color
35 as and similar to the design of the regular license plates that is
36 determined by the department.

37 3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall
38 issue special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is
39 currently registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross
40 weight, as defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or
41 less.

42 4. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, the
43 department shall charge the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each
44 annual renewal of special plates in addition to the registration fee
45 prescribed by section 28-2003.

46 B. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, on
47 notification to the department and on payment of the transfer fee

1 prescribed by section 28-2402, a person who is issued special plates may
2 transfer the special plates to another vehicle the person owns or leases.
3 Persons who are issued special plates for hearing impaired persons
4 pursuant to section 28-2408 and international symbol of access special
5 plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are exempt from the transfer fee. If a
6 person who is issued special plates sells, trades or otherwise releases
7 ownership of the vehicle on which the plates have been displayed, the
8 person shall immediately report the transfer of the plates to the
9 department or the person shall surrender the plates to the department as
10 prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to whom the
11 plates have been issued to knowingly allow them to be displayed on a
12 vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.

13 C. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which
14 registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates.

15 D. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who:

16 1. Violates subsection B of this section.

17 2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the
18 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
19 to this article.

20 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the
21 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
22 to this article.

23 Sec. 3. Title 28, chapter 7, article 12, Arizona Revised Statutes,
24 is amended by adding section 28-2470.27[, 28-2470.28, 28-2470.29,
25 28-2470.30, 28-2470.31 and 28-2470.32], to read:

26 28-2470.27. 988 suicide awareness special plates

27 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE
28 DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
29 ISSUE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE
30 \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN
31 AND COLOR OF THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO
32 APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT.

33 B. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS
34 SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL
35 PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE
36 IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE
37 PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE 988
38 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES.

39 C. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL
40 SPECIAL PLATES AND FOR THE RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PLATES, \$8 IS A SPECIAL
41 PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND \$17 IS AN ANNUAL DONATION.

42 D. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND
43 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND
44 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND SHALL TRANSMIT ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED

[A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES. THE COLOR AND DESIGN OF THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES.

B. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL SPECIAL PLATES AND FOR THE RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PLATES, \$8 IS A SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND \$17 IS AN ANNUAL DONATION.

C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND SHALL TRANSMIT ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATE FUND ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION.

D. THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATE FUND IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF MONIES DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. THE FIRST \$32,000 IN THE FUND SHALL BE REIMBURSED TO THE PERSON THAT PAID THE IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. NOT MORE THAN TEN PERCENT OF THE MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE FUND ANNUALLY SHALL BE USED FOR THE COST OF ADMINISTERING THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED.

E. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE MONIES FROM THE FUND TO AN ENTITY THAT IS QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) OF THE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES. THE ENTITY MUST:

1. BE HEADQUARTERED IN THIS STATE.
2. HAVE BEEN INCORPORATED IN THIS STATE IN MARCH 1996.
3. EXCLUSIVELY SUPPORT ARIZONA CHILDREN'S CHARITIES THROUGH AT LEAST TWO ANNUAL FUNDRAISING EVENTS.
4. BE AFFILIATED WITH A MEMBERSHIP-BASED ORGANIZATION THAT IS HEADQUARTERED IN SCOTTSDALE, ARIZONA THAT CONSISTS OF AN ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP OF NOT MORE THAN SIXTY-FIVE MEMBERS UNDER FORTY YEARS OF AGE.

F. ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.]>>

17 2. PROMOTE THE WELL-BEING OF ITS AFFILIATE SORORITIES AND
18 FRATERNITIES, FACILITATE THE ESTABLISHMENT AND DEVELOPMENT OF LOCAL
