1 The bill as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; Arizona health innovation trust
3 fund; state treasurer; intent; exemption

4 A. The sum of [~~\$2,000,000~~] [~~\$250,000~~] is appropriated from the
5 state general fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the Arizona health
6 innovation trust fund established by section 41-177, Arizona Revised
7 Statutes.

8 B. The sum of [~~\$500,000~~] [~~\$250,000~~] is appropriated from the state
9 general fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the state treasurer to allocate
10 to the entity described in section 41-177, subsection E, Arizona Revised
11 Statutes, to conduct a pilot program that satisfies the requirements of
12 section 41-177, subsections E and F, Arizona Revised Statutes.

13 C. The legislature intends that the Arizona health innovation trust
14 fund, consisting of monies appropriated by the legislature, earnings from
15 the fund and gifts or grants donated or given to the fund as prescribed by
16 section 41-177, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes, steadily grow to
17 ultimately maintain a permanent endowment balance of at least
18 \$200,000,000.

19 D. The appropriation made in subsection B of this section is exempt
20 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
21 to lapsing of appropriations.
