2 Section 1. Appropriation; department of health services;

<u>ibogaine</u>; clinical study; exemption

- A. The sum of [\$10,000,000] [\$5,000,000] is appropriated from the 5 state general fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of health 6 services to award a grant pursuant to title 41, chapter 24, Arizona 7 Revised Statutes, to conduct a certified clinical research study on the 8 use of ibogaine for the treatment of neurological diseases, including 9 traumatic brain injury and post-traumatic stress disorder. The department 10 may award grants only to an entity that satisfies all of the following:
- 11 1. Has a history of proven research and treatment of neurological 12 diseases.
- 2. Has a neurosurgery program with the requisite clinical and 14 research facilities and that is staffed by professionals having expertise 15 in the most challenging neurological and neurosurgical conditions.
- 16 3. Has the ability to facilitate pioneering research and innovation 17 in diagnosis and treatment of neurological conditions.
- [4. Has demonstrated to the department that the entity has a commitment for matching monies of gifts, grants and donations from sources other than this state in the amount of at least \$5,000,000 to conduct the certified clinical research study on the use of ibogaine for the treatment of neurological diseases.]

- B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
- 2 from the provisions of section 35–190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
- 3 to lapsing of appropriations.
- 4 Enroll and engross to conform
- 5 Amend title to conform
