FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Removes a total of \$137,210 from the FY 2026 appropriation from the state General Fund to the Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) which includes:
 - a) \$62,000 for the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office; and**
 - b) \$75,210 for the Salt River Police Department (PD).****
- 2. Adds a total of \$256,000 the from the FY 2026 appropriation from the state General Fund to ADOA which includes:
 - a) \$84,000 for the Yavapai County Sheriff's Office;**
 - b) \$64,000 for the Prescott PD;**
 - c) \$54,000 for the Cottonwood PD; and**
 - d) \$54,000 for the Prescott Valley PD.****
- 3. Makes technical changes.**
