

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **HB2883**

Hernandez C. Floor Amendment

1. Specifies modalities by which trainings for school district governing board members (school board members) may be delivered.
2. Removes school district governance from the list of topics that must be covered by the training program developed by the Auditor General (OAG).
3. Requires each school board member to complete professional development training that may be provided by a nonprofit organization, professional association or other entity and specifies the topics that the professional development training must cover.
4. Requires a school board member to complete the training developed by the OAG and the professional development training at least once in every two-year period.
5. Deems an individual, who in the previous four years shared the same household of residence with an immediate family member who is a candidate for or member of a school board, to be eligible as a candidate or member of the same school board if the individual:
  - a. is under 20 years of age; and
  - b. currently resides in a different household than the immediate family member who is a candidate for or member of the school board.

7       A. IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL, THE  
8 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL  
9 DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD MEMBERS THAT [INCLUDES] [MAY BE DELIVERED THROUGH  
10 AN IN-PERSON WORKSHOP, A VIRTUAL WORKSHOP OR SELF-PACED ONLINE TRAINING  
11 MODULES OR ANY COMBINATION OF IN-PERSON WORKSHOP, VIRTUAL WORKSHOP AND  
12 SELF-PACED ONLINE TRAINING MODULES. THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL  
13 SHALL ESTABLISH THE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAINING PROGRAM  
14 DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION AND SHALL REQUIRE THE TRAINING

10      [B.] [C.] EACH GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT IN  
11 THIS STATE SHALL COMPLETE [BOTH] THE TRAINING DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO  
12 SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION [AND THE TRAINING REQUIRED PURSUANT TO  
13 SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION] AT LEAST ONCE IN EVERY TWO-YEAR PERIOD. [A  
14 SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER MAY SELECT AND COMPLETE ONE OR MORE  
15 TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT ARE PROVIDED BY A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION,  
16 PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION OR OTHER ENTITY THAT SPECIALIZES IN PUBLIC  
17 EDUCATION TO SATISFY THE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION B  
18 OF THIS SECTION.]

19      [C. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY CHARGE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR  
20 THE COST OF PROVIDING THE TRAINING DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF  
21 THIS SECTION. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PAY FOR ANY COSTS INCURRED BY THE  
22 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE THE TRAINING DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO  
23 SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.]"

<<Sec. 2. Section 15-421, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
25 read:

26      15-421. Governing boards; members; qualifications;  
27 prohibitions; candidate statements; definitions

28      A. The governing body of a school district shall be a governing  
29 board. There shall be three governing board members, except as otherwise  
30 provided by this section and section 15-425, subsection A.

31      B. The governing body of a high school district shall be a  
32 governing board composed of:

33       1. In a single district, the governing board members of the common  
34 school district.

35       2. In a union high school district, five members.

36       C. A person is eligible for election to the office of governing  
37 board member if all of the following apply:

38       1. The person is a registered voter of this state.

39       2. The person has been a resident of the school district for at  
40 least one year immediately preceding the day of election.

41       3. The person is not subject to registration as a sex offender in  
42 this state or in any other jurisdiction.

43       D. An employee of a school district, including a person who  
44 directly provides certified or classified services to the school district  
45 as an employee of a third-party contractor, or the spouse of such an  
46 employee may not hold membership on the governing board of a school  
47 district by which the employee is employed.

1       E. Notwithstanding subsection D of this section and title 38,  
2 chapter 3, article 8, a small school district may employ, including  
3 employment through a third-party contractor that provides services to the  
4 small school district, a substitute teacher who is related to a member of  
5 the governing board as immediate family and who has had the same household  
6 of residence within the preceding four years. If a small school district  
7 employs a substitute teacher pursuant to this subsection, the member of  
8 the governing board who is related to the substitute teacher shall be  
9 recused from voting on any matter relating to substitute teachers.

10     F. A school district may employ, including employment through a  
11 third-party contractor that provides services to the school district, a  
12 person who served as a member of the school district's governing board  
13 during the preceding two years only in a position in which the person will  
14 provide services directly to students, including as a certificated  
15 teacher, a substitute teacher and an employee or contractor who provides  
16 transportation, instructional support or student support services. A  
17 school district may increase the time period prescribed in this subsection  
18 to be more than two years.

19     G. A member of one governing board is ineligible to be a candidate  
20 for nomination or election to or serve simultaneously as a member of any  
21 other governing board, except that a member of a governing board may be a  
22 candidate for nomination or election for any other governing board if the  
23 member is serving in the last year of a term of office. A member of a  
24 governing board shall resign the member's seat on the governing board  
25 before becoming a candidate for nomination or election to the governing  
26 board of any other school district, unless the member of the governing  
27 board is serving in the last year of a term of office.

28     H. Notwithstanding section 15-511, each county school  
29 superintendent shall publish on the superintendent's website the statement  
30 of each certified candidate for membership on a school district governing  
31 board located in the county. The county school superintendent shall list  
32 each school district on the superintendent's website from which a link  
33 shall be established to the candidate's name, which shall link to the  
34 candidate's statement and photograph. The candidate shall submit the  
35 statement to the person at the county school superintendent's office  
36 assigned to manage candidate statements, after notice of certification  
37 from the county school superintendent's office but not later than  
38 twenty-one days before the date that general election early ballots are  
39 allowed to be mailed. The person shall post each candidate's statement on  
40 the county school superintendent's website not later than fourteen days  
41 before the date that general election early ballots are allowed to be  
42 mailed. If a candidate does not submit a statement, the county school  
43 superintendent's website shall state "no response submitted" for the  
44 candidate. The candidate statements shall be posted on the website  
45 alphabetically by each school district and by candidate. The candidate  
46 statement shall be typewritten or electronically submitted. The county  
47 school superintendent shall post the statements verbatim as they are  
48 received unless a candidate requests in writing that typographical errors

1 be corrected. The candidate statement shall contain the following items  
2 in the same size and format for each candidate:

- 3       1. A recent photograph of the candidate.  
4       2. A statement not to exceed five hundred words.

5       3. A disclosure of any relationships by affinity, by consanguinity  
6 or by law to the third degree that exist between the candidate and any  
7 current governing board members or other candidates for election to the  
8 same governing board.

9       I. Persons related as immediate family who have the same household  
10 of residence within four years prior shall not serve simultaneously on the  
11 governing board of the same school district if the governing board is  
12 composed of five members. For a school district with a student count of  
13 at least two hundred fifty that is located in a county with a population  
14 of more than five hundred thousand persons, not more than two persons  
15 related by affinity, by consanguinity or by law to the third degree shall  
16 serve simultaneously on the governing board of the same school district if  
17 the governing board is composed of five members. A qualified elector who  
18 resides in the school district may bring an action in superior court to  
19 enforce this subsection.

20       J. A person related as immediate family who has the same household  
21 of residence within four years prior to a member of the governing board of  
22 the same school district is ineligible to be a candidate for nomination or  
23 election to that governing board if the governing board is composed of  
24 five members, except that a person related as immediate family who has the  
25 same household of residence within four years prior to a member of a  
26 governing board may be a candidate for nomination or election to the  
27 governing board of the same school district if the member is serving in  
28 the last year of a term of office. For a school district with a student  
29 count of at least two hundred fifty that is located in a county with a  
30 population of more than five hundred thousand persons, not more than two  
31 persons related by affinity, by consanguinity or by law to the third  
32 degree shall be eligible to be a candidate for nomination or election to a  
33 governing board that is composed of five members. A qualified elector who  
34 resides in the school district may bring an action in superior court to  
35 enforce this subsection.

36       K. Persons related as immediate family who have the same household  
37 of residence within four years prior are ineligible to be simultaneous  
38 candidates for nomination or election to the governing board of the same  
39 school district if the governing board is composed of five members. For a  
40 school district with a student count of at least two hundred fifty that is  
41 located in a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand  
42 persons, not more than two persons related by affinity, by consanguinity  
43 or by law to the third degree shall be simultaneous candidates for  
44 nomination or election to a governing board that is composed of five  
45 members. A qualified elector who resides in the school district may bring  
46 an action in superior court to enforce this subsection.

47       [L. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTIONS I, J AND K OF THIS SECTION, AN  
48 INDIVIDUAL WHO IS RELATED AS IMMEDIATE FAMILY TO AND WHO HAD THE SAME

1 HOUSEHOLD OF RESIDENCE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS FOUR YEARS AS ANOTHER MEMBER OF  
2 OR CANDIDATE FOR NOMINATION OR ELECTION TO A SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING  
3 BOARD IS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE ON OR BE A CANDIDATE FOR NOMINATION OR ELECTION  
4 TO THE SAME SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD IF BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING  
5 APPLY:

6       1. THE INDIVIDUAL IS UNDER TWENTY YEARS OF AGE.  
7       2. THE INDIVIDUAL'S CURRENT HOUSEHOLD OF RESIDENCE IS NOT THE SAME  
8 HOUSEHOLD OF RESIDENCE AS THE OTHER GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER OR CANDIDATE.]

9       [~~T.~~] [M.] For the purposes of this section:

10       1. "Household of residence" means the place of abode during  
11 applicable time periods or the residence address used by an individual for  
12 voter registration or property tax purposes.

13       2. "Immediate family" means individuals who are married to each  
14 other and any children of those individuals.

15       3. "Small school district" has the same meaning prescribed in  
16 section 15-901.>>
