## FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

---

1. Requires, by July 1, 2026, the Arizona Biomedical Research Centre (ABRC) to provide \$2,000,000 from the Medical Marijuana Fund (Fund), rather than \$5,000,000 annually for five consecutive years, to award competitive grants for marijuana clinical trials.
2. Requires, by July 1, 2028, the ABRC to provide an additional \$2,000,000 from the Fund if the Department of Health Services determines the Fund has at least two years of operational expenses without risk of deficit or the need to increase registry identification card fees.

2 pursuant to section 36-3501 and the chronic pain self management program.

3       3. \$10,000,000 to the governor's office of highway safety to  
4 distribute grants for the following purposes:

5           (a) Reducing impaired driving, including conducting training  
6 programs and purchasing equipment for detecting, testing and enforcing  
7 laws against driving, flying or boating while impaired.

8           (b) Equipment, training and personnel costs for dedicated traffic  
9 enforcement.

10          4. \$2,000,000 to the department to implement, carry out and enforce  
11 chapter 28.2 of this title.

12          5. \$4,000,000 to the department to distribute grants to qualified  
13 nonprofit entities that will provide outreach to individuals who may be  
14 eligible to file petitions for expungement pursuant to section 36-2862 and  
15 will assist with the expungement petition process. The department shall  
16 distribute grants pursuant to this paragraph on or before June 30, 2021.

17          6. \$2,000,000 to the department of health services to develop and  
18 implement, in conjunction with the department of economic security and  
19 other state agencies, a social equity ownership program to promote the  
20 ownership and operation of marijuana establishments and marijuana testing  
21 facilities by individuals from communities disproportionately impacted by  
22 the enforcement of previous marijuana laws. For the purposes of this  
23 paragraph, "marijuana establishment" and "marijuana testing facility" have  
24 the same meanings prescribed in section 36-2850.

25          7. \$1,000,000 to the department to fund programs and grants to  
26 qualified nonprofit organizations for education and community outreach  
27 related to chapter 28.2 of this title.

28          8. \$1,000,000 to the smart and safe Arizona fund established by  
29 section 36-2856.

30          F. After all costs incurred to implement, carry out and enforce  
31 this chapter and the rules adopted pursuant to this chapter are paid for  
32 fiscal year 2021-2022, the department shall transfer from the medical  
33 marijuana fund the following sums for the following purposes:

34           1. \$1,250,000 to the department for suicide prevention.

35           2. \$1,250,000 to the Arizona health care cost containment system  
36 for suicide prevention.

37           3. \$2,000,000 to the institute for mental health research for  
38 research to improve mental health services, research and education in this  
39 state.

40          4. \$2,000,000 to the department for the primary care provider loan  
41 repayment program and the rural private primary care provider loan  
42 repayment program established by chapter 21 of this title. The department  
43 shall prioritize rural providers in the areas of mental health care and  
44 behavioral health care if feasible and appropriate.

45          5. \$2,000,000 to the board of medical student loans for the  
46 purposes of title 15, chapter 13, article 7. The board shall prioritize

1 students who intend to practice in the area of psychiatry or other areas  
2 of practice that treat mental illness if feasible and appropriate.

3       6. \$5,000,000 to county public health departments, in proportion to  
4 the population of each county, for the purposes of addressing important  
5 public health issues and communities affected by drug addiction and  
6 incarceration.

7       7. \$1,000,000 to the department for the health care directives  
8 registry established pursuant to section 36-3291.

9       G. Monies transferred pursuant to subsection F of this section do  
10 not revert to the state general fund.

11     H. The director shall make a onetime transfer of \$250,000 from the  
12 medical marijuana fund to the department to provide grants for marijuana  
13 research studies pursuant to section 36-2812.

14     I. The director may use monies in the medical marijuana fund to  
15 contract with laboratories pursuant to section 36-2803, subsection I to  
16 comply with the proficiency testing requirements of this chapter for  
17 independent third-party laboratories and marijuana testing facilities. On  
18 or before July 1 of each year, the department shall report to the joint  
19 legislative budget committee expenditures made pursuant to this subsection  
20 for the preceding fiscal year.

21     Sec. 2. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,  
22 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2822, Arizona Revised  
23 Statutes, is amended to read:

24     36-2822. Arizona biomedical research centre: medical  
25                   marijuana fund: grants: marijuana clinical trials:  
26                   requirements

27     A. The Arizona biomedical research centre in the department shall  
28 provide competitive grants from monies in the medical marijuana fund  
29 established by section 36-2817 for marijuana clinical trials that are  
30 approved by the United States food and drug administration for evaluating  
31 both the safety and efficacy of using marijuana in humans and researching  
32 the impacts of marijuana interactions with prescription drugs,  
33 nonprescription drugs and illicit drugs.

34     B. Clinical trials funded pursuant to subsection A of this section  
35 shall be conducted by Arizona-based researchers from nonprofit  
36 organizations or universities, be approved by the United States food and  
37 drug administration, the United States drug enforcement administration and  
38 an institutional review board and be publishable in peer-reviewed medical  
39 and public health journals. The centre shall prioritize randomized  
40 controlled clinical trials that study the treatment of autism, epilepsy,  
41 post-traumatic stress disorder and pain.

42     C. Notwithstanding title 13, chapter 34, a person who receives a  
43 grant for a marijuana clinical trial pursuant to this section and any of  
44 the person's employees working on the clinical trial may not be charged  
45 with or prosecuted for possession of marijuana that is cultivated for  
46 medical use when the person is working on the clinical trial.

1       D. [ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2026.] the Arizona biomedical research  
2 centre ~~may~~ SHALL provide ~~[up to \$5,000,000 annually for five consecutive~~  
3 ~~years]~~[\$2,000,000] from the medical marijuana fund established by section  
4 36-2817 to administer and award competitive grants pursuant to this  
5 section. [ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2028, THE ARIZONA BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH  
CENTRE SHALL PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL \$2,000,000 FROM THE MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-2817 TO ADMINISTER AND AWARD COMPETITIVE  
GRANTS IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THE MEDICAL MARIJUANA FUND HAS AT  
LEAST TWO YEARS OF OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AND WILL NOT BE AT RISK OF A  
10 DEFICIT OR REQUIRE AN INCREASE IN REGISTRY IDENTIFICATION CARD FEES.] The  
11 centre ~~may~~ SHALL not use more than five percent of these monies for  
12 administrative purposes.

13       Sec. 3. Requirements for enactment: three-fourths vote

14       Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,  
15 sections 36-2817 and 36-2822, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this  
16 act, are effective only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths  
17 of the members of each house of the legislature.
