

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **HB 2455**

Livingston Floor Amendment

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1. Removes the appropriation for the Salt River Police Department (PD) and the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office.
 2. Lowers the appropriation to the Pinal County Sheriff's Office from \$600,000 to \$400,000.
 3. Appropriates the following amounts from the state General Funds in FY 2026 to the Arizona Department of Administration to distribute to the following entities:
 - a) \$100,000 for the Gila County Sheriff's Office;
 - b) \$100,000 for the Navajo County Sheriff's Office;
 - c) \$84,000 for the Yavapai County Sheriff's Office;
 - d) \$54,000 for the Cottonwood PD;
 - e) \$67,000 for the Prescott PD; and
 - f) \$54,000 for the Prescott Valley PD.
 4. Makes a technical change.
