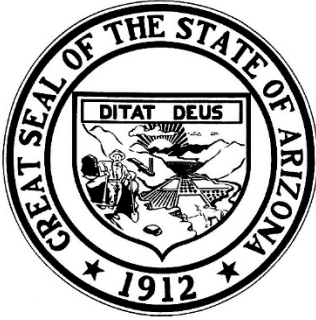


HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **HB 2748**

Weninger Floor Amendment

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1. Requires an operator to deliver an electronic ticket to the purchaser at least 15 days before the event, rather than on receipt of an order confirmation.
 2. Instructs the operator, for electronic tickets purchased less than 15 days before an event, to deliver the electronic ticket to the purchaser as soon as reasonably possible after the purchase.
 3. Requires a ticket reseller to clearly and conspicuously disclose an approximate delivery date for a ticket that is resold to a purchaser and that is to be delivered electronically.
 4. Adds the requirements relating to electronic ticket delivery do not apply to a ticket that is initially offered:
 - a. at no charge and access to that ticket is not contingent on providing a form of monetary consideration; and
 - b. for a charitable purpose where all proceeds from the ticket sale are provided to a charitable organization that qualifies as a 501(c)(3).

2 Section 1. Section 44-7201, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 44-7201. Definitions

5 In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

6 1. "Bot":

7 (a) Means any automated software program that performs automatic
8 and repetitive tasks and that is designed to impersonate or replicate
9 human activity online.

10 (b) Does not include autofill or password management features built
11 into an internet browser or provided through separate software.

12 2. "Event" means a concert, theatrical performance, sporting event,
13 exhibition, show or similar scheduled activity that meets all of the
14 following:

15 (a) Is open to the public.

16 (b) Is held in a public or private venue.

17 (c) Requires payment of an admission fee to attend the event.

18 3. "OPERATOR":

19 (a) MEANS A PERSON OR ENTITY THAT OWNS, OPERATES OR CONTROLS A
20 PLACE OF ENTERTAINMENT OR THAT PROMOTES OR PRODUCES ENTERTAINMENT AND THAT
21 SELLS A TICKET TO AN EVENT FOR ORIGINAL SALE.

22 (b) INCLUDES AN EMPLOYEE OF AN OPERATOR.

23 4. "ORIGINAL SALE" MEANS THE FIRST SALE OF A TICKET BY AN OPERATOR.

24 ~~5.~~ 5. "Ticket" means a physical or electronic certificate,
25 voucher, document, token or other evidence of a right for admission to
26 enter a place of entertainment for one or more events at one or more
27 specified dates and times.

1 Sec. 2. Title 44, chapter 29, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by adding section 44-7204, to read:

3 44-7204. Electronic ticket sales and resales; electronic
4 ticket delivery requirements; exceptions

5 [A.] AN OPERATOR SHALL DELIVER AN ELECTRONIC TICKET TO THE
6 PURCHASER ~~[ON RECEIPT OF AN ORDER CONFIRMATION.]~~ [AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS
7 BEFORE THE EVENT.]

8 B. IF A PURCHASER PURCHASED AN ELECTRONIC TICKET LESS THAN FIFTEEN
9 DAYS BEFORE AN EVENT, THE OPERATOR SHALL DELIVER THE ELECTRONIC TICKET TO
10 THE PURCHASER AS SOON AS REASONABLY POSSIBLE AFTER THE PURCHASE.]

11 C. A TICKET RESELLER SHALL CLEARLY AND CONSPICUOUSLY DISCLOSE AN
12 APPROXIMATE DELIVERY DATE FOR A TICKET THAT IS RESOLD TO A PURCHASER AND
13 THAT IS TO BE DELIVERED ELECTRONICALLY.]

14 D. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A TICKET THAT IS INITIALLY
15 OFFERED:

16 1. AT NO CHARGE AND ACCESS TO THAT TICKET IS NOT CONTINGENT ON
17 PROVIDING A FORM OF MONETARY CONSIDERATION.]

18 2. FOR A CHARITABLE PURPOSE FOR WHICH ALL PROCEEDS FROM THE TICKET
19 SALE ARE PROVIDED TO A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT QUALIFIES AS A
20 NONPROFIT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) OF THE UNITED
21 STATES INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.]
