FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

1. Determines that school mapping data that is produced for the School Mapping Data Program (Program) is not a public record or subject to public disclosure and is exempt from the public record requirements.
2. Removes, from the definition of *school* for the purposes of the Program, an accredited private school.
3. Makes conforming changes.

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 2, article 2, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-231.01, to read:

4 15-231.01. School mapping data program; fund; grants;
5 software and data requirements; annual
6 certification; public records exemption;
7 definition

8 A. THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PROGRAM IS ESTABLISHED IN THE DEPARTMENT
9 TO FACILITATE EFFICIENT EMERGENCY RESPONSES ON SCHOOL CAMPUSES BY ENSURING
10 THAT SCHOOL MAPPING DATA IS ACCURATE, STANDARDIZED AND ACCESSIBLE TO
11 PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP STANDARDIZED SCHOOL
12 MAPPING DATA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES, INCLUDING REQUIREMENTS
13 THAT DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

14 1. ENSURE THAT THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA SOFTWARE:

15 (a) IS COMPATIBLE WITH SOFTWARE PLATFORMS USED BY LOCAL, STATE AND
16 FEDERAL PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES THAT PROVIDE EMERGENCY SERVICES TO SCHOOLS
17 IN THIS STATE.

18 (b) DOES NOT REQUIRE A PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL
19 SOFTWARE OR PAY A FEE TO VIEW OR ACCESS THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA.

20 (c) INCLUDES SCHOOL MAPPING DATA IN A PRINTABLE FORMAT.

21 (d) DOES NOT ALLOW THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA FOR A SCHOOL SITE TO BE
22 MODIFIED OR UPDATED WITHOUT UPDATING THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA FOR THE
23 SCHOOL SITE WITHIN EACH PLATFORM THAT IS USED BY A LOCAL, STATE OR FEDERAL
24 PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY THAT MAY PROVIDE EMERGENCY SERVICES TO THE SCHOOL
25 SITE.

26 2. ENSURE THAT THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA IS ORIENTED TRUE NORTH,
27 OVERLAID WITH GRIDDED X AND Y COORDINATES AND INCLUDES ALL OF THE
28 FOLLOWING:

1 (a) ACCURATE FLOOR PLANS OVERLAID ON CURRENT, VERIFIED AERIAL
2 IMAGES OF THE SCHOOL CAMPUS.

3 (b) SITE-SPECIFIC LABELS THAT MATCH THE STRUCTURE OF EACH SCHOOL
4 BUILDING, INCLUDING ROOM LABELS, HALLWAY NAMES, EXTERNAL DOOR NUMBERS AND
5 STAIRWELL NUMBERS.

6 (c) SITE-SPECIFIC LABELS THAT MATCH THE SCHOOL GROUNDS, INCLUDING
7 PARKING AREAS, ATHLETIC FIELDS, ROADWAYS AND NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES.

8 (d) THE LOCATION OF EACH CRITICAL UTILITY, KEY BOX, AUTOMATED
9 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR AND TRAUMA KIT AND ANY KNOWN HAZARD AT EACH SCHOOL
10 SITE.

11 3. ENSURE THAT IF A SCHOOL CONTRACTS WITH A VENDOR TO PRODUCE
12 SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, THE CONTRACT INCLUDES
13 PROVISIONS ENSURING BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

14 (a) THAT PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES AND THE SCHOOL WILL HAVE PERPETUAL
15 ACCESS TO ALL SCHOOL MAPPING DATA AT NO ADDITIONAL COST.

16 (b) THAT EACH CONTRACTOR THAT PRODUCES SCHOOL MAPPING DATA WILL
17 VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THE DATA BY CONDUCTING A WALK-THROUGH OF ALL SCHOOL
18 BUILDINGS AND SCHOOL GROUNDS THAT ARE INCLUDED IN THE DATA.

19 B. EACH SCHOOL IN THIS STATE SHALL:

20 1. DEVELOP SCHOOL MAPPING DATA CONSISTENT WITH THE SCHOOL MAPPING
21 DATA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS
22 SECTION FOR EACH SCHOOL SITE THAT IS OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL.

23 2. ANNUALLY REVIEW SCHOOL MAPPING DATA FOR EACH SCHOOL SITE AND
24 EITHER:

25 (a) CERTIFY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA IS
26 COMPLETE AND ACCURATE AND MEETS THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PROGRAM
27 REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

28 (b) UPDATE THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA TO ENSURE THAT IT IS COMPLETE
29 AND ACCURATE AND MEETS THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS
30 ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

31 3. ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA FOR EACH SCHOOL SITE TO
32 EACH LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY THAT MAY PROVIDE
33 EMERGENCY SERVICES TO THE SCHOOL.

34 [C. SCHOOL MAPPING DATA THAT IS PRODUCED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
35 IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD, IS EXEMPT FROM TITLE 39, CHAPTER 1 AND IS NOT
36 SUBJECT TO PUBLIC DISCLOSURE.]

37 ~~[C.]~~ [D.] THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PROGRAM FUND IS ESTABLISHED
38 CONSISTING OF MONIES APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE AND GRANTS, GIFTS,
39 DEVICES AND DONATIONS FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCE. THE DEPARTMENT
40 SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY
41 APPROPRIATED AND ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190 RELATING
42 TO LAPSING OF APPROPRIATIONS. EACH SCHOOL IN THIS STATE MAY APPLY FOR A
43 GRANT IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT
44 SHALL DISTRIBUTE GRANTS FROM THE SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PROGRAM FUND TO
45 ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS IN THIS STATE ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS. A
46 SCHOOL THAT RECEIVES GRANT MONIES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION SHALL USE

1 THE MONIES FOR THE COSTS OF DEVELOPING SCHOOL MAPPING DATA PURSUANT TO
2 SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION.

3 ~~[D.] [E.]~~ FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL" MEANS A PUBLIC
4 SCHOOL ~~[OR AN ACCREDITED PRIVATE SCHOOL]~~ IN THIS STATE THAT OFFERS
5 INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS IN A KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM OR ANY OF GRADES ONE
6 THROUGH TWELVE.

7 Sec. 2. Appropriation; school mapping data program fund

8 The sum of \$10,360,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
9 in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the school mapping data program fund
10 established by section 15-231.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by
11 this act.
