FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Adds the establishment of a special plate and special plate fund for America250 and Italian Americans.
- 2. Requires the Director of the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) to allocate America250 Special Plate Fund monies to:
 - a) the Arizona America250 Commission, monthly through December 31, 2026, to pay costs related to America250 projects and events; and
 - b) the State Library Fund, annually beginning January 1, 2027.
- 3. Requires Director of ADOT to allocate Italian American Special Plate Fund monies to a qualified 501(c)(3) organization that meets outlined requirements.
- 4. Makes conforming changes.

1 The bill as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:

Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 3 read:

28-2351. <u>License plate provided; design</u>

A. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall provide to 6 every owner one license plate for each vehicle registered. At the request 7 of the owner and on payment of a fee in an amount prescribed by the 8 director by rule, the department shall provide one additional license 9 plate for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested pursuant to 10 this chapter.

B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the vehicle and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which may be abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a reflective material that is consistent with the determination of the department regarding the color and design of license plates and special plates. The director shall design the license plate and the letters and numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly

1 readable during daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition 2 to the standard license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005, 3 the director shall issue a license plate for trailers that has a design 4 that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that 5 is the same size as the license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner 6 shall notify the department which size license plate the owner wants for 7 the trailer.

- 8 C. In addition to the requirements prescribed in subsection B of 9 this section, for all license plates, including all special plates, that 10 are designed or redesigned on or after September 24, 2022:
- 1. The background color of the license plate shall contrast 12 significantly with the color of the letters and numerals on the license 13 plate and with the name of this state on the license plate.
- 14 2. The name of this state shall appear on the license plate in 15 capital letters in sans serif font and be three-fourths of an inch in 16 height.
- D. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract lawith a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a law reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many lindividual responsible respondents as possible.
- E. The department shall determine the color and design of the license plate subject to the requirements prescribed by subsections B and C of this section. All plates issued by the department, except the plates that are issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414, 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through $\frac{28-2470.26}{28-2470.35}$ [$\frac{28-2470.37}{28-2476}$] $\frac{28-2470.37}{28-2476}$ and $\frac{28-2470.37}{28-2470.37}$ and $\frac{28-2470.37}{28-2$
- 31 F. A passenger motor vehicle that is rented without a driver shall 32 receive the same type of license plate as is issued for a private 33 passenger motor vehicle.
- 34 Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 35 read:

28-2403. Special plates; transfers; violation; classification

- A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates are met:
- 1. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, a person 43 who is the registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or 44 who applies for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may 45 submit to the department a completed application form as prescribed by the 46 department with the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates 47 in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.
- 48 2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, $49\ 28-2413$, 28-2414, 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through $\frac{28-2470.26}{28-2470.26}$

1 [$\frac{28-2470.34}{28-2470.35}$] {{ $\frac{28-2470.37}{28-2472}$ }, 28-2473, 28-2474, 2 28-2475 and 28-2476 and article 14 of this chapter, the special plates 3 shall be the same color as and similar to the design of the regular 4 license plates that is determined by the department.

- 5 3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall 6 issue special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is 7 currently registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross 8 weight, as defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or 9 less.
- 4. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, the 11 department shall charge the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each 12 annual renewal of special plates in addition to the registration fee 13 prescribed by section 28-2003.
- B. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, on 15 notification to the department and on payment of the transfer fee 16 prescribed by section 28-2402, a person who is issued special plates may 17 transfer the special plates to another vehicle the person owns or leases. 18 Persons who are issued special plates for hearing impaired persons 19 pursuant to section 28-2408 and international symbol of access special 20 plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are exempt from the transfer fee. If a 21 person who is issued special plates sells, trades or otherwise releases 22 ownership of the vehicle on which the plates have been displayed, the 23 person shall immediately report the transfer of the plates to the 24 department or the person shall surrender the plates to the department as 25 prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to whom the 26 plates have been issued to knowingly allow them to be displayed on a 27 vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.
- C. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates.
 - D. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who:
 - 1. Violates subsection B of this section.

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- 32 2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the 33 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant 34 to this article.
- 35 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the 36 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant 37 to this article.
- <<Sec. 3. Section 28-2416, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 39 read:

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28-2416. Alternative fuel vehicle special plates; stickers;

use of high occupancy vehicle lanes; civil penalty; definition
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A. A person who owns a motor vehicle that has either been converted 44 or manufactured to use an alternative fuel as the vehicle's exclusive fuel 45 source and that is incapable of operating on any other type of fuel and 46 the alternative fuel was subject to the use fuel tax imposed pursuant to 47 chapter 16 of this title before April 1, 1997 shall apply for alternative 48 fuel vehicle special plates pursuant to this section.

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- B. The department shall issue alternative fuel vehicle special plates, or an alternative fuel vehicle sticker as provided in subsection D of this section, to a person who satisfies all of the following:
- 4 1. Owns a motor vehicle that is exclusively powered by an 5 alternative fuel and that is incapable of operating on any other type of 6 fuel.
 - 2. Provides proof as follows:
- 8 (a) For an original equipment manufactured alternative fuel 9 vehicle, the dealer who sells the motor vehicle shall provide to the 10 department of transportation and the owner of the motor vehicle a 11 certificate indicating:
- 12 (i) That the motor vehicle is exclusively powered by an alternative 13 fuel and is incapable of operating on any other type of fuel.
- 14 (ii) The emission classification of the motor vehicle as low, 15 inherently low, ultralow or zero.
- 16 (b) For a converted motor vehicle or a motor vehicle that is 17 assembled by the owner, the department of environmental quality or an 18 agent of the department of environmental quality shall provide a 19 certificate to the department of transportation and the owner of the motor 20 vehicle indicating that the motor vehicle is exclusively powered by an 21 alternative fuel and is incapable of operating on any other type of fuel.
- 3. Pays an [eight dollar] [\$8] special plate administration fee, 23 except that vehicles that are registered pursuant to section 28-2511 are 24 exempt from that fee. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 25 35-146 and 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state 26 highway fund established by section 28-6991.
- C. The color and design of the alternative fuel vehicle special plates are subject to the approval of the governor's energy office. The director may allow a request for alternative fuel vehicle special plates to be combined with a request for personalized special plates. If the director allows such a combination, the request shall be in a form prescribed by the director and is subject to the fees for the personalized special plates in addition to the fees required for alternative fuel vehicle special plates. Alternative fuel vehicle special plates are not transferable, except that if the director allows alternative fuel vehicle special plates to be personalized a person who is issued personalized alternative fuel vehicle special plates to second plates to describe the special plates may transfer those plates to another alternative fuel vehicle for which the person is the registered owner or lessee.
- D. If a motor vehicle qualifies pursuant to this section and any 41 other special plates are issued pursuant to article 7, 8 or 13 of this 42 chapter or section 28-2414[, 28-2470.29] or 28-2514 for the motor vehicle, 43 the department may issue an alternative fuel vehicle sticker to the person 44 who owns the motor vehicle. The alternative fuel vehicle sticker shall be 45 diamond-shaped, shall indicate the type of alternative fuel used by the 46 vehicle and shall be placed on the motor vehicle as prescribed by the 47 department.

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- E. Except as provided in section 28-337, a person may drive a motor 2 vehicle with alternative fuel vehicle special plates or an alternative 3 fuel vehicle sticker in high occupancy vehicle lanes at any time, 4 regardless of occupancy level, without penalty.
- F. A person shall not drive a motor vehicle in a high occupancy 6 vehicle lane with an alternative fuel vehicle sticker if the motor vehicle 7 is not an alternative fuel vehicle for which an alternative fuel vehicle 8 sticker has been issued pursuant to this section. A person who violates 9 this subsection is subject to a civil penalty of [three hundred fifty 10 dollars] [\$350]. Notwithstanding section 28-1554, the civil penalty 11 collected pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the state 12 general fund.
 - G. For the purposes of section 28-337, the department shall:
- 14 1. Limit or suspend the issuance of alternative fuel vehicle 15 special plates.
- 16 2. Remove the privilege of operating in the high occupancy vehicle 17 lane with a single occupant, including the driver.
- 18 H. If the department publishes maps of the state highway system 19 that are distributed to the general public, the department shall indicate 20 on those maps the approximate location of alternative fuel delivery 21 facilities that are open to the public.
- I. For the purposes of this section, "alternative fuel" has the 23 same meaning prescribed in section 1-215.>>

THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES.
- 41 C. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL 42 SPECIAL PLATES AND FOR THE RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PLATES, \$8 IS A SPECIAL 43 PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND \$17 IS AN ANNUAL DONATION.
- D. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 45 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND 46 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND SHALL TRANSMIT ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED 47 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATE FUND 48 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-123.04.

A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES. THE COLOR AND DESIGN OF THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES.

THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN AND COLOR OF THE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PRESONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES.
